

Proceedings of the 27th Research-Extension Linkage Meeting, KVK, Jagatsinghpur

The 27th Research - Extension linkage meeting of KVK, Jagatsinghpur was held on 30.10.18 at 3 PM in the Training hall of KVK under the Chairmanship of Dr. BiswaRanjanPattanaik, Senior Scientist & Head, KVK, Jagatsinghpur. The meeting was attended by ADVO(DC) Jagatsinghpur, Agronomist (O/O DAO, Tirtol), AFEO, Reliance foundation and progressive farmer from different blocks of the district.

Dr. BiswaRanjanPattanaik, Sr. Scientist & Head, KVK, Jagatsinghpur at the outset welcomed all the line department officials for their august presence. He presented the proceedings of the previous meeting and action taken report of KVK. He then requested the entire Heads of Line department to work in convergence mode in adopted villages of KVK, where the DFI programme is operating. He requested the ADVO, Jagatsinghpur to conduct atleast one animal health camp each in DFI villages of KVK. In this regard, the ADVO advised to inform the BVO of the concerned block for conducting the animal health camp.

Sri NrusinghaCharanBehera of village Haripur requested the Senior Scientist & Head of KVK to conduct an animal health camp in village Haripur of Kujanga Block. In this regard, the Senior Scientist & Head suggested conducting the camp in liaison with Veterinary department. He also requested the ADVO to find out a solution for repeat breeding problem arising in Haripur village. In this context, the ADVO informed that repeat breeding problem can be solved by mineral mixture supplementation with green fodder. He also suggested conducting a camp involving veterinary scientist of KVK, Gynaecologist and mobile veterinary van.

Sri NrusinghaBehera of Sahardia village requested the ADVO to conduct the animal health camp in Sahardia village and needed advice on any availability of financial aid for preparation of cowshed and supply of cow feed. He also sought the advice of Agronomist (O/O DAO, Tirtol) on procedure for sale of greengram by the FPO formed in his village.

There was a scientific discussion among the house members on “Weed Management in Transplanted Rice”, “management of stem borer” and “Acid Soil Management”

The scientists of KVK presented their action plan for the month of Nov, 18. The programmes on ‘Demonstration of Power weeder in cauliflower’ and ‘Weed management in Groundnut’ are to be conducted in Tirtol, Kujanga and Ersama block of the district.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks by Mr. B.K. Rautray, Scientist (Plant Protection) to the Chair and participating members.
